## RCH Visits Summer Library Program



The Plainville Library recently asked RCH if they would give a short presentation about CPR to the children who are part of the Summer Library Program. We were happy to send Angela Hahn and Tinley Oehm to teach the children, ages 6 to 12, about the basic function of the cardiovascular system and the importance of early recognition of sudden cardiac arrest. The students were given three simple steps to follow in response to a sudden collapse of someone around them. They



learned to check the person for a response, call 911, and begin hard, fast compressions. “Stayin Alive” by the Beegees provided the backdrop for the hands on portion of the class as students learned the proper form, depth and rate of compressions.

The kids were also excited when they were given the opportunity to hear heart and lung sounds when provided with stethoscopes.



The goal of hands only CPR is to empower bystanders to act when sudden cardiac collapse is witnessed by making CPR as simple and non-threatening as possible. This early education will hopefully provide these young people with a foundation of knowledge to step in if they witness an emergency.
